Hi Ross

As you know we had a termite infestation about 6 months ago. (December 2002)
They devoured half the timber framework to the lower section of my house to the extent that my house almost totally collapsed under the strain..

We called in a Pest Controller who sprayed lots of chemicals in and around the house and he assured us that every thing would be ok . (Meaning that they wouldn't come back)

I started to reframe the damaged walls myself and I thankfully installed your monitors into the wall cavities as I reconstructed each new wall section.

You can imagine my surprise when I pulled out one of your monitors to find out they were back, after just 6 months.

I know for sure that if I hadn't used your devices I would have been rebuilding all these wall sections not knowing that these bloody termites would have been devouring the new frame work as fast as I was replacing it. (Like painting the Harbour bridge. Once you're finished its time to start from the other end again)

I got another Pest Controller in to access the new infestation. He said that because we found the termites early that they didn't have time to cause any more serious damage.

The Pestie sprayed again but told me that there wasn't much strength in todays chemicals so he suggested that I keep a constant eye on the monitors.
He even suggested that I carry out weekly termitecta inspections for the first few months to be on the safe side.

So thanks again ...

Please feel free to use this letter. I have written it because I feel you have a terrific and simple little product. I hope that telling my particular story may help people understand the devastating damage that termites can cause.

If I had fitted your monitors last year (before the first infestation) I would have detected them early, **before** they caused all this damage, and all the drama that came with it.
